

## C.G.L. NEWSLETTER 10-26-15

The 2015-16 CGL Season is off to a great start. All results were reported by the 24<sup>th</sup> of the month. My thanks to all of you for getting us off to a timely start!

Regarding the P File exchange please note that most of our Managers DO NOT have the capability to process P Files. October results were reported on one P File by several Managers, which works for me, but there were no details listed regarding individual series results. A few Managers had to ask me for series W-L results. I am asking ALL Managers to send Series Statistics for visiting teams for all series starting in November. It only takes a couple of minutes to copy and paste results from Statmaster to an Excel Spreadsheet. If you need help with the process let me know. You may also send P Files to your opponents. All I need are the P Files each month. Any other questions let me know.

It looks like another pitching dominated CGL Season is upon us. Six teams have ERA's under 3.10 while three teams are hitting .207 or less. There are already 10 pitchers with two Shutouts to their credit and 15 Starters with an ERA of 2.60 or less. After only one month we have but eight hitters above the .300 mark. I have attached the CGL Standings through 38 games, Team Hitting and Pitching as well as League Leaders in Hitting and Pitching through October.
